
Annwyl riant/warchodwr,

Llyfrynn Iaith Language Booklet



Y mae Llyfrynnau iaith fel y rhai uchod yn cael eu cwblhau gan ddisgyblion blwyddyn 7, 8 a 9 yn ystod y cyfnodau cofrestru drwy'r flwyddyn ysgol er mwyn gloywi iaith y dysgwyr yn y Gymraeg. Mae'r llyfrynnau yn rhoi sylw i reolau gramadeg gan annog y dysgwyr i gwblhau tasgau iaith i brofi a datblygu eu dealltwriaeth o sut i ysgrifennu'n gywir yn y Gymraeg.

A Language Booklet like the ones shown above has been completed by year 7, 8 and 9 pupils during registration periods throughout the school year in order to improve the pupils' language skills and grammar in Welsh. The booklet concentrates on grammatical rules that encourage pupils to complete tasks that tests and improves their comprehension of how to write correctly in Welsh.

Mae gan bob ystafell ddosbarth yn yr ysgol bellach Wal Llythrennedd. Mae nifer o bosteri fel y rhai uchod ar y wal er mwyn tynnu sylw at gamgymeriadau cyffredin sy'n codi yng ngwaith y disgyblion ac i atgoffa nhw o reolau iaith yn y Gymraeg a'r Saesneg. Y gobaith yw i wella ansawdd yr ysgrifennu ar draws holl bynciau'r cwricwlwm.

Every classroom in the school has a Literacy Wall by now. A number of posters like the ones above are on the wall in order to draw attention to common mistakes that appear in the pupils' work and to remind them of grammatical rules in Welsh and in English. The hope is to improve the quality of writing across all subjects of the curriculum.
